



# Notice of Race

## 1 RULES

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS 2009-2012) and applicable fleet rules.

## 2 FLEET RULES

Fleet Rules must be on file with, and approved by, the Arizona Yacht Club (AYC) Fleet Captain before the entry closing date.

## 3 FLEETS

This series is open to dinghies and catamarans under 20 feet LOA. Any fleet with four (4) or more registrants by the entry closing date may get its own start.

## 4 ENTRIES

A completed AYC entry form and entry fee must be received by the AYC Fleet Captain by Wednesday, June 6, 2012 to establish a fleet. Online registration is preferred, but entry forms are published on the AYC web site, [www.arizonayachtclub.org](http://www.arizonayachtclub.org). Newcomers and visitors are encouraged to participate.

## 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be published on the web at [www.arizonayachtclub.org](http://www.arizonayachtclub.org). Copies may be obtained from the AYC Fleet Captain and from the race committee. Individual fleet rules may be obtained from the fleet captains.

## 8 ALTERATIONS TO RULES

- 8.1 Each boat shall display sail numbers designated on its accepted registration. This modifies rule 77.
- 8.2 All boats are encouraged to fly a yacht club burgee. This modifies rule 55.

## 9 COURSES TO BE SAILED

The race area is shown on the current Arizona Yacht Club Tempe Town Lake Course Chart Revision C. Courses to be sailed are shown on the same chart.

## 10 SCORING

- 10.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 A boat starting later than ten (10) minutes after her starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start" (DNS). This changes rule A4.2.
- 10.3 A boat may retire (RET) from a race and receive a score equal to the number of starters for that race, except if she starts alone in her fleet she shall sail the entire course to be scored as a finishing boat. This changes rule A4.2.
- 10.4 Unless changed by fleet rules, discards shall be 20% (rounded down) of all races in the series.
- 10.5 Only boats registered for the series will receive series scoring.

## 11 PRIZES

Prizes for the series are based on the number of participating boats in each class or fleet and awarded as follows:
