Students should have completed the Start Sailing Right Class or have equivalent experience. Students will sail in Lasers and Sunfish (one person boats – single handed sailing).

The ASF course will build knowledge and confidence sailing on the protected waters of Tempe Town Lake. Topics include sailing theory, boat handling, safety, right-of-way, knots, and docking. We'll work to prepare students to enjoy time on the water.

The instructors are US Sailing certified and have enjoyed many years on, around and in the water. You'll need to provide your own PFD (type III "life jacket") and your prerequisite Start Sailing Right included swimming 50 yards in sailing clothes. You are neither too young nor too old. Sailing is FUN and you should sign up!
