1 RULES

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012* (RRS) and applicable class and fleet rules.
- 1.2 Fleet Rules must be on file with, and approved by, the Arizona Yacht Club (AYC) Fleet Captain before the entry closing date.

2 FLEETS

Any fleet with five (5) or more series registrants by the entry closing date of 1st race date of the series at 1230 may get its own start and will be deemed an "active fleet" as referred to in the AYC bylaws. Any fleet with fewer than five (5) entrants by the entry closing date may get its own start but will not be deemed an "active fleet" as referred to in the AYC bylaws.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Entry forms are published on the AYC web site, www.arizonayachtclub.org. Newcomers and visitors are encouraged to participate.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be published on the AYC web site at www.arizonayachtclub.org. Copies may be obtained from the AYC Fleet Captain. A limited number will be available for newcomers at the race committee boat. Individual fleet rules may be obtained from the fleet's captain.

7 ALTERATIONS TO RULES

- 7.1 STARTING RACES. AYC fleet boards may be substituted for class flags. This modifies rule 26.
- 7.2 IDENTIFICATION ON SAILS. Each boat shall display sail numbers designated on its accepted registration. This modifies rule 77.
- 7.3 All boats are encouraged to fly a yacht club burgee. This modifies rule 55.

8 COURSES TO BE SAILED

The race area and course to be sailed are shown on the current Arizona Yacht Club Lake Pleasant Course Chart, Revision K.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 A boat starting later than fifteen (15) minutes after her starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start" (DNS). This changes rule A4.
- 9.3 A boat may retire (RET) from a race and receive a score equal to the number of starters for that race, except if she starts alone in her fleet she shall sail the entire course to be scored as a finishing boat. This changes rule A4.
- 9.4 Boats failing to finish within 45 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored "Time Limit Expired" (TLE). This time limit, but not scoring, may be modified by fleet rules. Boats identified TLE shall be scored points equal to the number of boats finishing within the time limit plus two points without a hearing. This changes rule A4.
- 9.5 Unless changed by fleet rules, discards shall be 20% (rounded down) of all races in the series.
- 9.6 Per day entrants will not be scored for the series.

10 PRIZES

Prizes for the series are based on the number of participating boats in each class or fleet and awarded as follows:
