AYC Capri 14.2 Fleet Rules Submitted September 12, 2014

- 1. A member of the entrant's immediate family must be onboard, but there are no restrictions as to who may serve as helmsman or crew.
- 2. The combined weight of helmsman and crew must be a minimum of 300 pounds. A skipper (with or without crew) is allowed to race by adding secured ballast sufficient to bring the combined human/ballast weight to 300 pounds. (No scales = Corinthian Spirit)
- 3. An entrant is responsible for verifying that the RC has the entrant's name and sail number for scoring. Failure to do so will result in a "did not compete (DNC)" score. Adopt-a-boat and one-day registrants be especially careful.
- 4. If the first boat in a race has not rounded the first mark within 30 minutes, we ask the RC to shorten course to finish the fleet at that mark. If the RC does not shorten course, the race is abandoned.
- 5. Boats not competing (DNC) will be given a score equal to the number of boats starting a race plus one.
