

PHRF Non-Spin Fleet Rules

Submitted Spring 2010 and in effect until further notice

1. If the lead boat in a race does not cross the finish within two hours, the race will be abandoned.
2. A vote of sixty percent (60%) or more of the fleet members present is required for the fleet to either stop racing on a given day or to decide not to proceed to race on any given day (e.g., in the event of bad weather).
3. The fleet prefers a mixture of race courses, not all of any single type (e.g., X, triangle or windward/leeward).
4. The fleet will sail under the Southern California PHRF Class Rules, effective November 2009 (available at <http://www.arizonayachtclub.org/Racing/PHRF-Non-Spinnaker/index.shtml>) except for the following exceptions:
 - a. PHRF Certificates are not required.
 - b. If a boat's SoCal PHRF rating is not available, the US Sailing PHRF average handicap rating will be substituted.
 - c. Appendix B equipment (page 17) is not required.
