

**Notice of Race**  
Arizona High School Double-Handed Sailing Championship Regatta  
April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013  
Tempe Town Lake, Arizona

Activities near the lake on Saturday April 20<sup>th</sup> include the Pat Tillman Run (20,000 people estimated). Access to the lake may be limited to walking into the boat area before 10 am.

**1 RULES**

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016* (RRS). Advertising will be restricted to Category C (see ISAF Regulation 20).

**2 FLEETS**

Only Capri/Catalina 14.2's will be sailed.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

This is an open regatta but limited to students who reside in Arizona. The skipper/helmsman a Jr. or Sr. High School student (middle school will qualify as Jr. High School if student part of ASF class at TTL). Crew may be any school-age student. A completed entry form and entry fee must be received by the entry closing date of Saturday, April 13, 2013. Entries received after the entry closing date must include a \$10 late fee. Entry will be official when received by Race Regatta Chairman, George Tingom.

**4 FEES**

Arizona High School Championship Regatta entry fee \$25. Late fee: \$10

**5 SCHEDULE**

**RACE DATES AND TIMES**

One-Day Regatta April 20, 2013

First Warning Signal on Saturday 30 minutes after skipper's meeting.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, at 10 am in the vicinity of the grassy knoll, TTL marina.

**6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be published on the AYC web site at [www.arizonayachtclub.org](http://www.arizonayachtclub.org). Copies may be obtained from the ASF Regatta Chairman. A limited number will be available at the Skipper's Meeting.

**7 ALTERATIONS TO RULES**

**7.1 STARTING RACES.** A 14.2 class flag will be raised on the pontoon safety boat.

**7.2 IDENTIFICATION ON SAILS.** Each boat shall display sail numbers designated on its accepted registration. This modifies rule 77.

**8 COURSES TO BE SAILED**

The race area will be the east basin of Tempe Town Lake and courses to be sailed will be a combination of short triangle or windward/leeward courses.

**9 SCORING**

**9.1** One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

**9.2** A boat starting later than ten (10) minutes after her starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start" (DNS). This changes rule A4.

**9.3** A boat may retire (RET) from a race and receive a score equal to the number of starters for that race, except if she starts alone in her fleet she shall sail the entire course to be scored as a finishing boat. This changes rule A4.

**9.4** Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored "Time Limit Expired" (TLE). Boats identified TLE shall be scored points equal to the number of boats finishing within the time limit plus two points. This changes rule A4.

**9.5** Discards will be 20% of races sailed rounded down with at least one throw out if at least two races are sailed. (e.g., if two or up to nine races, then one race will be discarded).

**10 PRIZES**

Winning skipper and crew member receive individual trophies and a perpetual trophy to be displayed at their school.
