



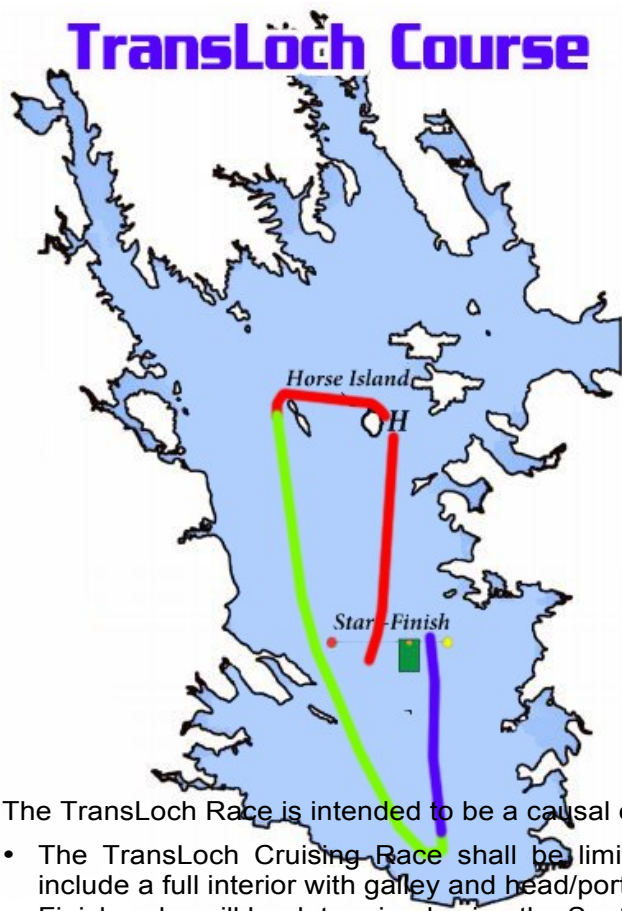
## TransLoch Sailing Instructions

January 16, 2016

Lake Pleasant, Arizona



The TransLoch Cruising Race shall be limited to boats that are fully equipped to cruise. The boats shall include a full interior with a galley and a head, a minimum of two anchors, Dacron or nylon sails only and an operational motor. Finish order will be determined using Southern CA PHRF handicap. Handicap adjustments will be allowed as follows: Towing a dinghy: 10; cooking on BBQ: 6; children under 6 years of age: 2 each; each pet over 10 lbs.: 2 each. Sailing instructions and advice will be available on VHF Channel 68

The Starts will be broadcast on VHF with a countdown. **The TransLoch Start will be at 10:30 AM.**



The TransLoch Cruising course shall be from the start line, around the north side of Horse Island, then around the north side of Balance Rock, then around the south side of the small unnamed island (with permanent vegetation) at the south end of Lake Pleasant near the dam overlook visitors center (33°51.07 N, 112°16.57 W), and then to the finish line. Round all marks to Port.

Starting Sequence:

5 min	<b>Fleet board displayed</b>
4 min	 <b>Prep flag up</b>
1 min	 <b>Prep flag down</b>
0 min	<b>Fleet board down - Start of race</b>

NOTE:

- All boats must check in by sailing aft of the Race Committee on starboard tack and hailing FLEET, SAIL NUMBER, SKIPPER'S name before the race
- **All boats must hail the race committee as they approach the finish line.**
- A boat that retires from a race or retires from racing before the end of the race day shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

The TransLoch Race is intended to be a causal event with minimal rules and maximum fun.

- The TransLoch Cruising Race shall be limited to boats fully equipped for cruising. The boats shall include a full interior with galley and head/port-a-potty, Dacron or nylon sails and an operational motor.
- Finish order will be determined using the Southern California PHRF handicaps.
- Instructions and advice will be available on VHF channel 68. This changes rule 41. Starts will be broadcast on Channel 68 with a countdown.
- The Start will be 10:30 AM or shortly after.
- The course shall be one lap around the islands as shown on the right.
- Protests are permitted, but discouraged. Entrants are expected to follow the Racing Rules of Sailing, and behave in a Corinthian (sportsmanlike) fashion, taking penalties as appropriate.
- Awards will be presented to the top 3 finishers.

SKIPPER'S MEETINGS (IMPORTANT) - Will be held in the vicinity of 'Lookout Point' overlooking Pleasant Harbor Marina. Saturday 1-16-16 at 9:00 AM

FLEET IDENTIFIER – All boats in the TL Fleet are asked to fly a streamer of any length or color off the backstay
