

Notice of Race

Arizona High School Sailing Championship Regatta

May 5, 2018

Tempe Town Lake, Arizona

1 RULES

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020* (RRS). Advertising will be restricted to Category C (see ISAF Regulation 20).

2 FLEETS

Laser One Design boats will be sailed.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This is an open regatta but limited to students who reside in Arizona. The skipper is a Jr. or Sr. High School student (middle school will qualify as Jr. High School if student is part of ASF class at TTL). A completed entry form and entry fee must be received by the entry closing date of Thursday, May 3, 2018 to qualify for early bird entry. Entry will be official when received by Race Regatta Chairman indicated below.

4 FEES

Arizona High School Championship Regatta early bird entry fee \$25. After 5/3/2018 the regular fee \$35 applies. **Less 50 % of subtotal if current ASF student (\$12.50 or \$17.50).**

5 SCHEDULE

RACE DATES AND TIMES

One-Day Regatta Saturday May 5, 2018

First Warning Signal on Saturday 30 minutes after skipper's meeting AND after morning dragon boat event has left the lake.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: Saturday, May 5, 2018, at 3pm in the vicinity of the grassy knoll, TTL marina.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be published on the AYC web site at www.arizonayachtclub.org. Copies may be obtained from the ASF Regatta Chairman. A limited number will be available at the Skipper's Meeting.

7 ALTERATIONS TO RULES

IDENTIFICATION ON SAILS. Each boat shall display sail numbers designated on its accepted registration. This modifies rule 77.

8 COURSES TO BE SAILED

The race area will be determined at time of regatta. South or North expected wind, the race may be held in the FAR East Basin. West or East expected wind, the race may be held in the central east basin of Tempe Town Lake. Courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward.

9 SCORING

9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

9.2 A boat starting later than five (5) minutes after her starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start" (DNS).

This changes rule A4.

9.3 A boat may retire (RET) from a race and receive a score equal to the number of starters for that race. This changes rule A4.

9.4 Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored "Time Limit Expired" (TLE). Boats identified TLE shall be scored points equal to the number of boats finishing within the time limit plus one point. This changes rule A4.

9.5 Discards will be 20% of races sailed rounded down with at least one throw-out if at least four races are sailed. (e.g., if four or up to nine races, then one race will be discarded).

10 PRIZES

Winning skipper will receive an individual trophy and a perpetual trophy to be displayed at their school.
