

## Arizona Yacht Club SANTANA 20 Fleet Rules

1. Rules apply until modified or rescinded by a vote of Santana 20 AYC entrants (past or present) and communicated to the AYC Racing Fleet Captain by the Santana 20 Fleet Captain.
2. The Santana fleet WILL allow spin and non-spin racing within the S-20 Fleet.
  - 2.1. Non-spin will be given an offset/handicap of 9 seconds, for a PHRF rating of 231, while the spinnaker Santana20 is PHRF of 222.
  - 2.2. When checking in with the R/C each day of racing, the skippers will declare to the R/C if they will be racing WITHOUT using their spinnakers. If so declared, the R/C will jot down the sail number and mark those competitors as racing without spinnakers on the score sheets for that day.
  - 2.3. The default is to race with spinnakers. The burden to declare is on the competitors who opt to sail without spinnakers. If no declaration is made, it is assumed that the boats will be sailing with spinnakers.
  - 2.4. The Scorekeeper shall make provisions to add the offset/handicap to those sailing without spinnakers.
3. Boats sailing in the Santana 20 Fleet shall conform to the specifications relating to the physical / performance attributes of the Santana 20, presented in the Santana 20 association website: <https://www.s20.org/>, more specifically the "Santana 20 Class Association Yearbook 2019-2020."
  - 3.1. Requirements not associated with physical / performance attributes, such as Class Association membership, Class Association Sail Royalty Tags, and regatta conduct, shall not apply.
  - 3.2. Requirements for measurement certification shall not apply, however if a boat is protested as not in compliance with the class association specifications, measurements may be taken by the protest committee.
4. Boats that are either DNC (did not come to the starting area) or DNS (did not start) shall be scored equal to the number of boats starting the race plus one. This modifies rule A4.2.
