



# Notice of Race

Arizona Yacht Club Spring 2022  
Tempe Town Lake, Arizona

1. **Rules.** The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and applicable class and fleet rules, which are available from fleet captains.
2. **Sailing Instructions.** Sailing Instructions are available at [arizonayachtclub.org](http://arizonayachtclub.org) website.
3. **Eligibility.** The regatta is open to sailboats allowed on Tempe Town Lake, racing under one-design or an agreed upon handicap system.
4. **Entry.** Boats may enter by submitting a form and the required fee online at [arizonayachtclub.org/racing](http://arizonayachtclub.org/racing). To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
5. **Fees.** AYC members TTL only, \$30; Non-members TTL only, \$55; Junior members TTL, \$25; ASU Student TTL only \$0; AYC members LP & TTL, \$95; Non-members, \$175; Day entry only, \$15.
6. **Schedule.** January 16&30, February 27, March 13&27, April 3,10&27. First warning signal at 2 pm during January and February; 3 pm during March and April. No warning signal will be sounded more than two and a half hours after the first scheduled warning.
7. **Venue and Courses.** Race venue and courses to be sailed are described on Tempe Town Lake Chart C available on the [arizonayachtclub.org](http://arizonayachtclub.org) website.
8. **Scoring.**
  - a) One race is required to constitute a series.
  - b) A boat starting later than five (5) minutes after her starting signal will be scored "did not start" (DNS). This changes rule A4.
  - c) Rule A5.3 will apply. A5.3 will be modified so that boats that do not come to the starting area will be scored one more than the number of boats that come to the starting area.
  - d) After starting, a boat may retire (RET) from a race and receive a score equal to the number of starters in that race, except if she starts alone in her fleet, she shall sail the entire course to be scored as a finishing boat. This changes rule A4.
  - e) A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst 20% (rounded down).
  - f) Day entries will not be scored for the series. This changes rule A2.2.
9. **Prizes.** Prizes are awarded for each fleet with at least 5 entries and is based on number boats entered in the series for each fleet: 5-6 entries, one award; 7-9 entries, two awards; 10+ entries, three awards.
10. **Championship Race Qualification.** Only champions of active fleets plus the current AYC Club Champion are eligible to participate in the AYC Club Championship Regatta. The annual champion of an active AYC fleet shall be the AYC member entrant with the lowest combined score, determined by combining an entrant's final NET scores for the fall and spring series. A fleet must meet the active fleet qualification of 5 series entrants in both the Fall and Spring Racing Series by the first day of each of the series. To be eligible to compete in the Championship Regatta, the entrant must have obtained full or junior membership status before the final race of the spring series. The Junior Fleet has its own Championship trophy governed by their fleet rules, available on the [arizonayachtclub.org](http://arizonayachtclub.org) website.
11. **Disclaimer of Liability.** Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes. In addition, each person understands and accepts all risk of exposure to communicable disease.

**Note:** Race entrants and race crews are expected to assist with their fleet's race committee duty.
