

PHRF Sport Boat Fleet Rules

Arizona Yacht Club, Lake Pleasant

Submitted Spring 2022 and in effect until further notice

1. Boats eligible to compete in the PHRF Sport Boat Fleet shall be monohull sailboats using asymmetrical spinnakers. The fleet may vote to accept additional boats of other types.
2. The fleet may race on both scheduled weekend days but will score only Saturday results for trophies and annual fleet championship. For 2021-2022, fall Saturday-Sunday results will be combined with spring Saturday results to determine the fleet champion.
3. A vote of fifty percent (50%) or more of the fleet members competing that day is required to determine whether the fleet will stop racing for the day or will not race on a given day (e.g., in the event of bad weather). Entrants who have retired are presumed to vote "no." The fleet captain will vote last.
4. The fleet captain may request a start from the race committee prior to the published time if all the boats racing that day are present.
5. The fleet will sail under the current Southern California PHRF Class Rules, except as follows:
 - a. PHRF certificates are not required.
 - b. If a boat's SoCal PHRF rating is not available, the US Sailing PHRF average handicap rating will be substituted.
 - c. Viper 640 handicap shall be 102; J/70 shall be 117.
