

ADOPT-A-BOAT BOAT USE CHECK-OUT

A designated member of AYC must verify and sign-off on the following Boat Use Criteria:

AYC MEMBERSHIP:

- AYC membership verification.

GENERAL HEALTH & FITNESS SELF-ATTESTATION:

- ability to swim unaided for 50-yards while wearing a PFD (life jacket).
 - a swim test may be required.
- overall health & fitness sufficient to safely enable rigging, launch, operation, sailing, self-rescue, righting, & reboarding, haul-out, and stowage of the boat without endangering oneself or others. Some or all of these actions may require considerable exertion.
- no significant vision or hearing impairment.

SAILING EXPERIENCE:

- Any of the following:
 - known past history of safe sailing of similar boats with AYC.
 - verified completion of ASA 101 or US Sailing Small Keelboat class.
 - demonstrated ability to:
 - Rig the sailboat
 - Sail upwind
 - Sail downwind
 - Sail on a beam reach
 - Tack
 - Jibe
 - Dock

CARE OF ADOPT-A-BOATS:

- Launch the sailboat:
 - Sunfish & Lasers: hand-launch the boats using a dolly from the dock.
 - C-14.2 sailboats: trailer, and launch the boat using your own tow vehicle.
- Recover the boat:
 - Sunfish & Lasers: recover the boat using a dolly and haul the boat to the staging area or boatyard.
 - C-14.2 sailboats: recover the boat, secure it on the trailer, and transport the boat into the boatyard using your own tow vehicle.
- Properly de-rig and stow the boat and associated gear.

ORIENTATION:

- Orientation completed at TTL Boatyard, including:
 - Safety briefing and sign-off
 - Signature on Boat Use Agreement
